Stand Against Violence

At Midsomer Norton Primary school, we are always looking for ways to prepare our children to be good citizens and protect themselves in the wider world. Our Year 6 pupils will have a 'Stand Against Violence' workshop on Thursday 29th of September. This workshop was delivered to our year six pupils last year and the feedback we received was good from children and parents.

Statistics show that in 2019 there were 1.4 million incidences of violence in England and Wales with 60% of these involving young people. We want to prepare our children to be aware that each one of these incidences has the potential for life changing consequences, resulting in serious injury or death, the impact of grief on families and friends as well as destroyed futures of the perpetrators.
