For PSHE we follow the Jigsaw program. This term we will be looking at Being Me in My World.

Year 2 maths we will begin by recapping the children's knowledge of place value to 100- looking at the order of numbers and their tens and ones. We will then move on to addition and subtraction of 2 digit numbers (not crossing the 10).

Year 1 maths we will begin by recapping the children's knowledge of place value within 10- looking at the order of numbers and their values. We will then move on to addition and subtraction looking at the part whole model.

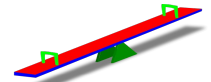


This term Mr Groves will teach PE on a Tuesday and Wren Woods will be every Friday.
