When you have applied Jenny will contact you to arrange an informal telephone interview with a teacher. Please do not worry about this, the interview is the start of you and the teacher getting to know each other and ensuring you are on the best course for your future plans.

Step into Strode is a new initiative for all applicants. It enables you to start finding out more about the courses you have applied for by participating in Zoom lessons and completing engaging tasks, while also developing some of the skills you will be using when you start with us.
