## KS3 Camp Activities Week 2023

We are delighted to inform you that we have arranged to take our Year 7, 8 & 9 students on a residential activity trip to PGL Barton Hall Adventure Centre, Devon, from 17th July 2023 to 21st July 2023. In addition 40 students from Year 7 will also have the opportunity to travel to Normandy for 2 nights 18th to 20th July 2023. The full details will be available next week.

Residential courses organised by schools are invaluable and enriching as part of the National Curriculum. The Government has stated the beneficial effects of learning outside the classroom and the impact this has on a child's progress that such courses provide. Learning outside the classroom offers new and exciting challenges, children will learn to work together as a team, develop independence, confidence and an ability to recognise strength and weaknesses in a constructive way. The value of giving children the opportunity to try out new activities cannot be underestimated.

At PGL Barton Hall Adventure Centre there are fully trained and qualified instructors, with the support of school staff, providing instruction in a full programme of activities in a safe controlled and secure environment. We do reserve the right to not take any student whose attendance and behaviour in school may give us cause for concern whilst away. All students participating in this trip are required to abide by the school rules at all times and will sign a conduct agreement for travelling. If a student jeopardises anyone's safety, well-being or the school's reputation, s/he will be sent home immediately, accompanied by a member of staff, the cost of which will be borne by parents.

The total cost of the visit to PGL Barton Hall Adventure Centre is £270.00 (pupil premium students, £200.00) and includes: accommodation, food, transport from the school to the centre and return, fully qualified instruction during activities, specialist & safety equipment, an evening activities programme, achievement certificates and comprehensive insurance.

To apply for a place for your child; please complete the consent form below, and return to St Dunstan's school office by Wednesday 8th February. Once we have received your consent slip, **parent pay** (online) will be opened for the initial deposit of £45 (pupil premium £30, which must be before **Friday 17**th February in order to secure the booking.
