 English	Writing Story writing (linked to The Nowhere Emporium) Biography of a monarch Poetry	Reading Whole class guided reading exploring vocabulary, inference, predictions explanations, retrieval and summarising.	SPAG Y5/6 words plus Y3/4 revision: Rules incl. adding suffixes -er, -ing to verbs; words containing 'y' where it sounds like 'i'; words ending -sure, -ture, -cious, -tious, -cial, -tial
 Maths	Year 5 Place Value (Roman Numerals, numbers to 1,000,000), Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division	Year 6 Place Value (numbers to 10,000,000), Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division	 French Children will recap previous knowledge as well as learn how to tell the time and how to talk about meals including their opinions about food.
 Science	Forces and Magnets: Children will understand that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of gravity. They will investigate air and water resistance and friction. They will also consider levers, pulleys and gears.	 History	Our focus topic for this term is Monarchy. Children will consider significant monarchs throughout British history and consider how key events such as the civil war and the Reformation have impacted the monarchy.
