

English



This term, we will be looking at two different types of writing: non-chronological reports and recounts. The children will be learning about the key features of each, and writing their own. Their non-chronological reports will be on habitats, and their recounts will focus on our trip to the Lavender Farm!

Science

Our topic this term is Everyday Materials and Their Uses. The children will learn about the properties and uses of plastic, metal, wood, brick, stone, glass, water, fabric and paper. They will explore different examples of these materials, and compare them.

Maths

This term, Year 1 will be looking at Multiplication and Division (counting in 2s, 5s and 10s), Fractions (halves and quarters) and Position and Direction. Year 2 will be learning about Fractions (halves, quarters and thirds) and Time.

Trips



We will be visiting the Lavender Farm on Wednesday 8th May. This trip is in relation to our History topic, Changes Over Time in Farming, but also ties in with our recount writing in English!

Music



We are learning about musical vocabulary this term. We will look at pulse, tempo, dynamics, timbre, pitch, rhythm, texture and structure. Our theme is 'Under the Sea'.

Art



We are developing our printing skills this term. The children will be creating monoprints, block prints and relief prints using various objects, inspired by artists such as Orla Kiely, William Morris and Roy Lichtenstein!
