Schools Timings from September

A reminder that there are two inset days in the week we return to school after the Summer Break. Children will be due back on Tuesday 5th September. From this day onwards, school gates will be open from 08.35am, with the register taken at 8.45am. Parents are encouraged to use the rolling drop off on the yellow zig-zag lines, as long as a member of staff is supervising. If you need to park and accompany your child in to school, then cars must not be parked on the zig-zag lines during this busy time.

A reminder that we encourage the use of the voluntary one-way system, coming down from Faulkland and heading out towards the Frome Road.

Breakfast Club and After School Club will run as normal for school children (YR-Y6). A reminder that if you are entitled to Free School Meals, these clubs are available free of charge. Otherwise, we ask for a contribution of £2.50 per child towards the cost of running Breakfast Club and £2.00 per child for After School Club.

School Open Days


We invite families to visit school on the days listed below for a tour and the chance to ask questions. Please share with any friends or family members who are considering school choices for September 2024.


