Update from Governors

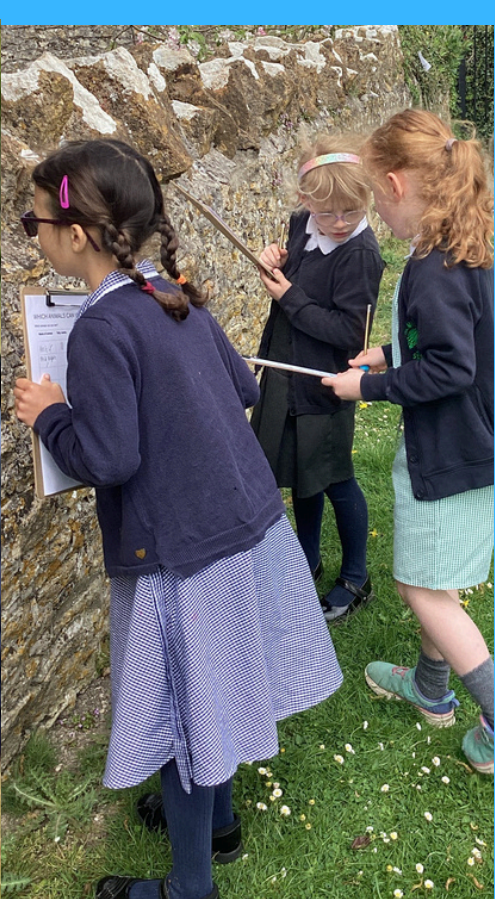
Great news – attendance has improved at both Hemington and Leigh on Mendip. Governors were really pleased to hear that families are working closely with staff to support this.
