#### **Maths Fundamentals**

As a school we have been focussing on the importance of Maths Fundamentals. Part of this is learning and using and applying, the 2-12 timetables. Each day the children are exposed to the tables through songs, rhymes and various maths challenges.. Once familiar with them and through questioning techniques (to ensure the children know and apply them) we present the children with individual tables badges to celebrate their achievement. These will be added to our celebration assembly each week as we ask the children to wear them as part of their uniform-with pride! As one of our children has displayed this week- age is just a number and all children are capable

#### Reception

Who is afraid of the Big Bad Wolf? Definitely not Bumblebee Class!

We have delved into the wonderful world of Fairytales and the children have immersed themselves into this by describing the characters, identifying the villains and retelling these stories with alternative endings or characters. This has sparked some fantastic writing of CVC words within Literacy.

Our focus in Maths has been the composition of numbers and using one more and one less. We've used part-part-whole models to find different ways to make amounts to 5.

Our artistic skills have been displayed during our visits to the Picasso Room. Whilst listening to different types of Music we thought about how our paintbrush should respond to the different types of Music. We have also created pictures inspired by 'Flanders field' to conclude our learning on why we use poppies to remember.











#### Year 1

We were visited by Lin and Will from the China Ren Society at Bath University. We discussed the human and physical features of Shanghai, and compared these similarities and differences with Midsomer Norton. Year 1 looked at the outskirts of the city, and how houses are often on the river. Lin showed us a traditional dress from Shanghai. We compared Bath and Shanghai. We also looked at a map of Shanghai and how densely populated it is. The children learned about PuDong, and that 'Pu' means 'river'. We explored how buildings have changed through time.

In Art, we have been learning about how to mix primary colours to create secondary colours, and what vocabulary such as 'shade' and 'hue' means.
