## **Important: Uniform Update**

Dear Parents/Carers,

With the temperature increasing again in the next few days and Enrichment Week next week, we are temporarily adjusting our uniform policy to keep our students comfortable.

Below are the uniform guidelines that all students are expected to follow:

### **Thursday 10th July**

- Blazers and ties are optional. Shirts must be tucked in.
- Knee-length shorts or pleated skirts are permitted. We may ask students to adjust skirts to an appropriate length if necessary.
- Students should wear black socks and formal black shoes in line with our school policy.

### **Friday 11th July**

To coincide with the celebration carnival and other events, students have the option to wear their PE Kit. This includes a St Dunstan's logo PE top, black shorts, trainers, and sports socks. Students are also welcome to continue wearing their school uniform if they prefer.

### **Enrichment Week**

Students are not expected to wear school uniform for in-school activities or offsite trips. We ask that students dress appropriately for a school setting and for the specific activities they will be involved in. Trip leaders will provide any further information as required.

---

### **Staying Comfortable & Hydrated**

Over the next few weeks, we also recommend the following:

- Please send your child with a **full water bottle every day** to help them stay hydrated.
- Consider having them bring a **sensible hat** to protect them from the sun during breaks.
- Ensure your child applies **sunscreen** if they will be outside for extended periods, such as during PE lessons or excursions.
- **Short-sleeve shirts** can be a cooler choice.
