### Headteacher's Award



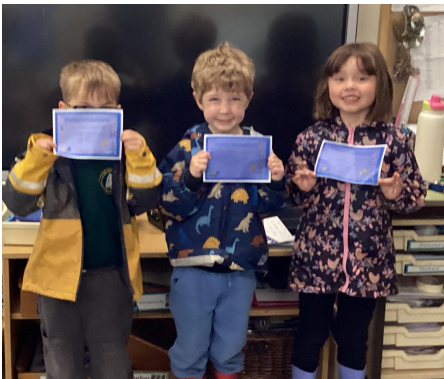
Well done to Alayah-Mae, Zander, Noah, Harry and Millie for receiving the headteacher's award this week.
