This time the children need to be on foot so we can assess if scooting/biking would be an option in the future.



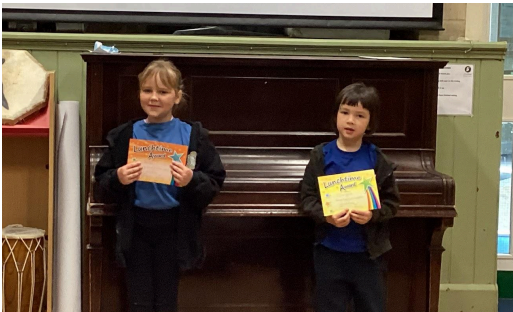
