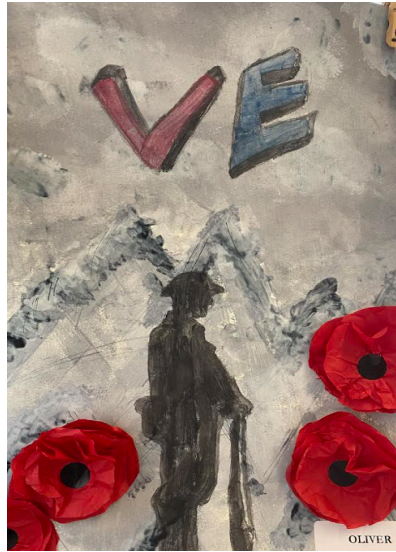




This week, the children have been busy finding out about VE day and have been producing art work and flags ready for the village day on Saturday. Many thanks to Mrs Willcox for organising this.
