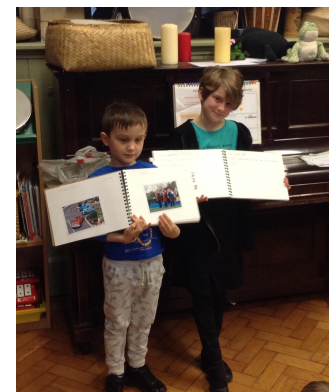


### **Headteachers' Award**
