MULTI SPORTS CLUB


We have employed a new sports company to run our multisports club.

PH sports work in many other schools in our area and are highly thought of.


The aim will be for the club to run on Thursdays 3.15-4.15 with the first session beginning on Thursday 25th January.

The children with the most stars in their class are:


Doodle Maths - Reuben, Johannes, Phoebe, Teddy, Elsie, Charlie and Fraser.
