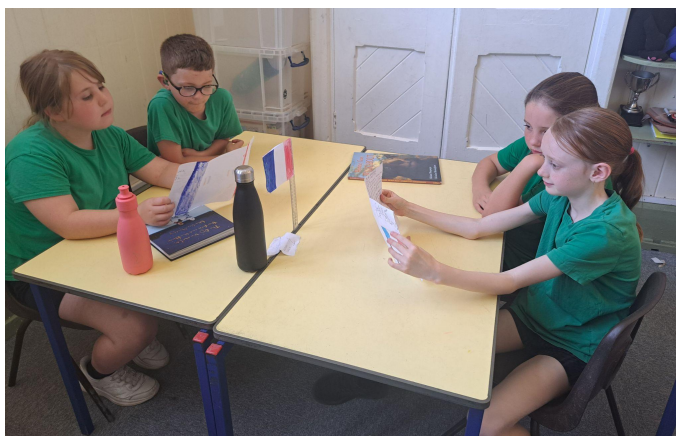




And that is a wrap for the academic year 2025/26. Here are a few photos to capture the highlights of the week.
