Mr Withers showed us his hens, his cows, some of his calves, the milking parlour and even his huge bull. We also learned what cows eat, where they live, and how they are milked. The day before our trip, one of the children asked me, "How does milk get into the cows?". One child thought that cows drink milk from buckets. Another child thought, "they eat coconuts, because coconuts have milk in them!" Hopefully, the whole class now know that cows eat grass and cleverly turn it into milk in their bodies.

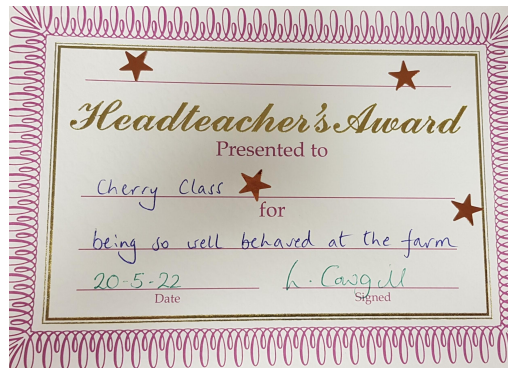

#### Headteachers' Award

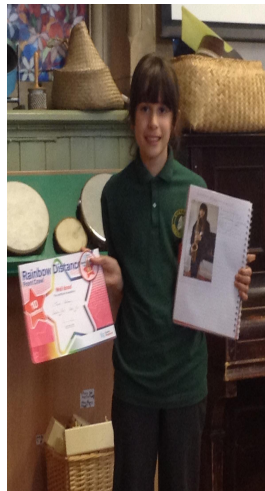
The recipients of the Head Teachers Awards this week are:
