



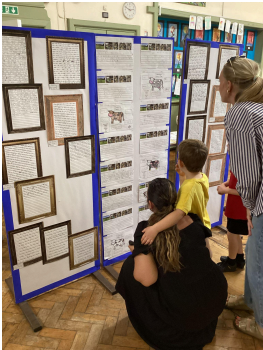
Well here we are, already at the end of term 5. Term 6 is already shaping up to be extremely busy with new dates being added to the diary all the time - please keep checking for updates.
