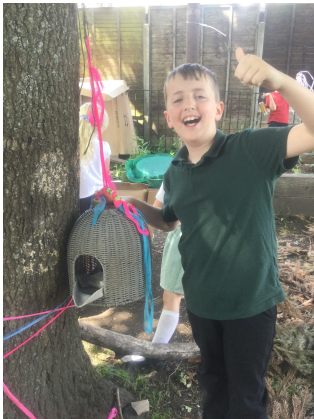

In other news, we held our New Parents Information evening on Tuesday. It was lovely to welcome in both new and existing families and we are now all really excited to meet the new Cherries over the next few weeks as they attend our 'stay and play' sessions.

Finally we have been busy carrying out end of year assessments, writing reports and collating attendance figures. We are very disappointed to see that so many children currently have an attendance figure of less than 93% (in normal years we would expect an average attendance figure of 96%). We understand that the rise in the cost of living is making holidays abroad unaffordable for some families in the school holidays, but please consider your child's education needs before booking a holiday in term time especially if they have missed schooling due to COVID and other illness. Our initial analysis of the end of year assessments show that there is a direct correlation in many cases between children's attendance and progress. A reminder that if a child averages 93% in the seven years at primary school, that means they will miss 94 days off school - the equivalent of approximately half a school year.
