Notices

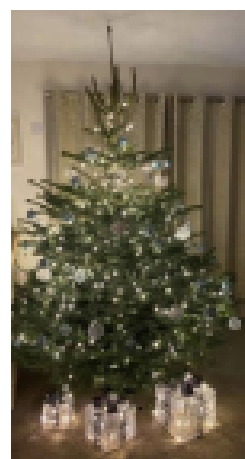
