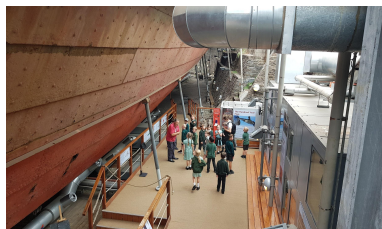
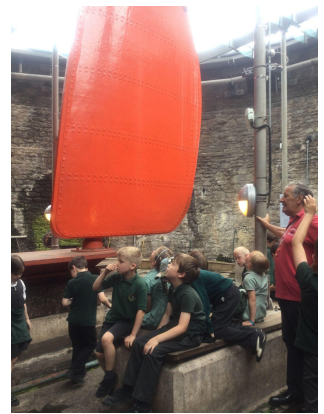

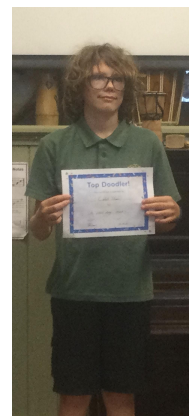


Congratulations Molly, Henry, Emily, Johannes, Teddy and Maddie for receiving the Head Teacher's award this week.
