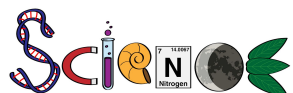

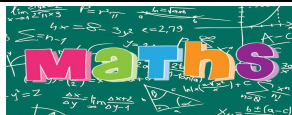

Count in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from 0 and in tens from any number, forward and backward.  
Read and write numbers to at least 100  
Recognise the place value of each digit in a two digit number (tens, ones)  
Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs.  
Use place value and number facts to solve problems.  
Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100.  
Add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and mentally,  
Solve problems with addition and subtraction



Focus books - Handa's Surprise, Vlad and the Great Fire of London, The Hodgeheg  
Whole class reading - meaning of words across the curriculum, improved fluency.  
Decoding unknown words quickly using phonics knowledge and reading words containing suffixes
