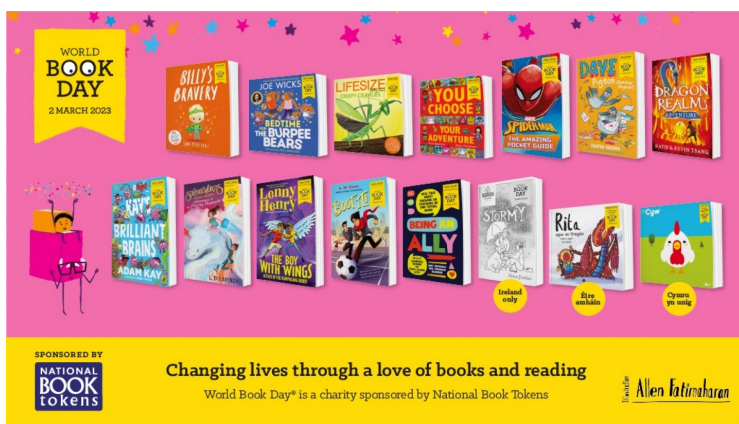


Tuesday 21st February 2023
