Geography GCSE Fieldtrip – Wednesday, 12th June 2019

The Geography Department has planned an important fieldtrip to Avalon Marshes for Year 10. During the trip students will be investigating small-scale ecosystems. The fieldwork will be delivered by staff from the Avalon Marshes Centre.

In order for the trip to run, we would need a voluntary contribution of **£12** per student to cover our cost, via Parent Pay by Monday 3 June 2019. Students who are entitled to Pupil Premium the total cost is £6.00.

We will leave school by coach at 9 am and return by 3 pm. Students should wear sensible weather-appropriate clothing, old trainers/wellies and bring an all-weather coat. They should also bring a packed lunch, snacks and a pen and pencil. Clip boards and a camera/camera phone would also be useful. If your child receives free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided by the school kitchen if required.

Students will be accompanied by Mrs Manning and two other members of staff. There will be occasions when students will be working in groups or pairs in the vicinity of, but not under the direct supervision of staff. Students are that good behaviour is expected at all times.

It is very important that your son/daughter attends this field trip which provides the data to complete their paper 3 exam. This exam paper is worth 30% of the final mark.
