## Year 6 London Trip on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> June: Final Arrangements

Dear Parents,

**On Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> June** we will have our annual Year 6 trip to London. Fortunately, the West End will be open, therefore we will be watching the matinee performance of *Wicked* at the Apollo Victoria theatre! Of course, we will also take in some of the nation's most famous landmarks, including: Big Ben, The Houses of Parliament; Downing Street; Buckingham Palace; as well as several of the parks.

**All children will need to arrive at school for 7:40am** as we will be departing by coach at 8:00am. The children will require a **packed lunch and packed tea for the journey home, plus snacks**. We will eat lunch in one of London's parks, therefore we ask that the packed lunch be in a disposable bag so that all waste can be put in a litter bin.

*If your child is entitled to free school meals, they may have a packed lunch provided by the school. Please let the school office know by Thursday 2nd June if they would like a school packed lunch.*

The children will need to wear their school PE T-shirt, school sweatshirt (not leavers hoodies), leggings, jeans or shorts and trainers (we may be walking around a little!) and a coat in case it rains.

The arrangements are as follows:

- Leave school at 8.00am (to ensure we arrive in London mid-morning)
- Take in the sights
- Lunch in a park
- Watch 'Wicked the Musical'
- Departing from London at 5:15pm. (We expect to be back at approx 9:30pm, however, we will keep you informed using the messaging service)

An ice cream and drink has already been paid for at the theatre, therefore, the children will not need any spending money.
