Mock Examination - November 2025

It was a pleasure to see so many students and parents at our Year 11 Information Evening on Thursday. For those who were unable to attend the event I would invite you to view our year 11 webpage - 'Year 11 Exam Information and Support', which is in the 'Information for students and parents' section of our website.

As part of our Year 11 programme we run mock examinations in November and March. The November examinations are scheduled for the **fortnight beginning 10th November**.

There are several reasons we run mock exams:

- (1) It enables both teachers and students to identify areas for improvement.
- (2) Our students get practice working in exam conditions and are more confident when they come to sit their final GCSE examinations.
- (3) Where subjects have a Higher & Foundation tier, it informs us which tier is likely to be more appropriate for your child.

It is important that students are now building revision schedules, if they have not already. The school will be running sessions in tutor time that teaches students about what effective revision looks like. I am currently in the process of finalising the timetable for the November mock series and I will write to you again when this has been confirmed.
