Dear Parent/Carer

We are delighted to offer children in Year 3 swimming lessons next academic year. Our Year 3 pupils will attend swimming lessons in terms **1, 3 and 5**. Year 4 will be attending in terms 2, 4 & 6.

The lessons will be on a Wednesday afternoon and the dates for their lessons are;

Term 1 - 6th, 13th, 20th, 27th September, 4th, 11th & 18th October

Term 3 - 3rd, 10th, 17th, 24th, 31st January & 7th February

Term 5 - 17th, 24th April, 1st, 8th, 15th & 22nd May

Please ensure your child/ children bring the following to school on the days of swimming lessons-

Swimming goggles

Boys require fitted trunks and girls a full costume.

Towel

Named bag

Long hair should be securely plaited in a single strand.

Please name every item of clothing and swimming kit.

We request you do not send talcum powder/body sprays. We expect children to be able to dry and change independently.

Unfortunately due to increased financial pressures on the school and the increased cost of providing swimming, we must ask for a voluntary contribution of £2 per session. The full amount of £38.00 which will cover all 3 terms lessons can be paid now if you wish or if you prefer can be paid in small amounts over the course of the year. Please make your contribution via ParentPay.

To help us group the children before their first session, it would be a great help if you could advise if your child already attends swimming lessons and if so what stage/ grade they are currently working towards. Please email your responses to office@midsomernortonprimary.co.uk.
