Dear Parent/Carer

As lockdown restrictions ease across the country, we are delighted to confirm that we will be able to continue with swimming lessons in line with government guidance for year 4 children in Term 5 and Term 6.

Swimming begins at Paulton Pool on **Tuesday 20th April** for Year 4 children for 10 weeks. The children will be accompanied by 2 members of staff. We will leave school at 1.00pm and return at approximately 2:45pm. Due to Covid19 restrictions, there will be no lockers and no showers available.

Children should bring their Swimming Kit in a **named** carrier bag or swimming bag. **They should also take it home the same day!**

For health and safety reasons, no jewellery should be worn, long hair must be tied back or a swimming cap should be worn and boys should wear conventional trunks rather than bermuda shorts.

I have also been asked to remind you that glasses should not be worn in the pool and that any child suffering from asthma must report to their swimming instructor (if this is not their teacher) at the beginning of the first session and **must** bring their inhaler to each swimming session.

Finally may I remind everyone that swimming forms part of the National Curriculum and that, as with Games, children will need a note from their parents if they are unable to take part at any time.
