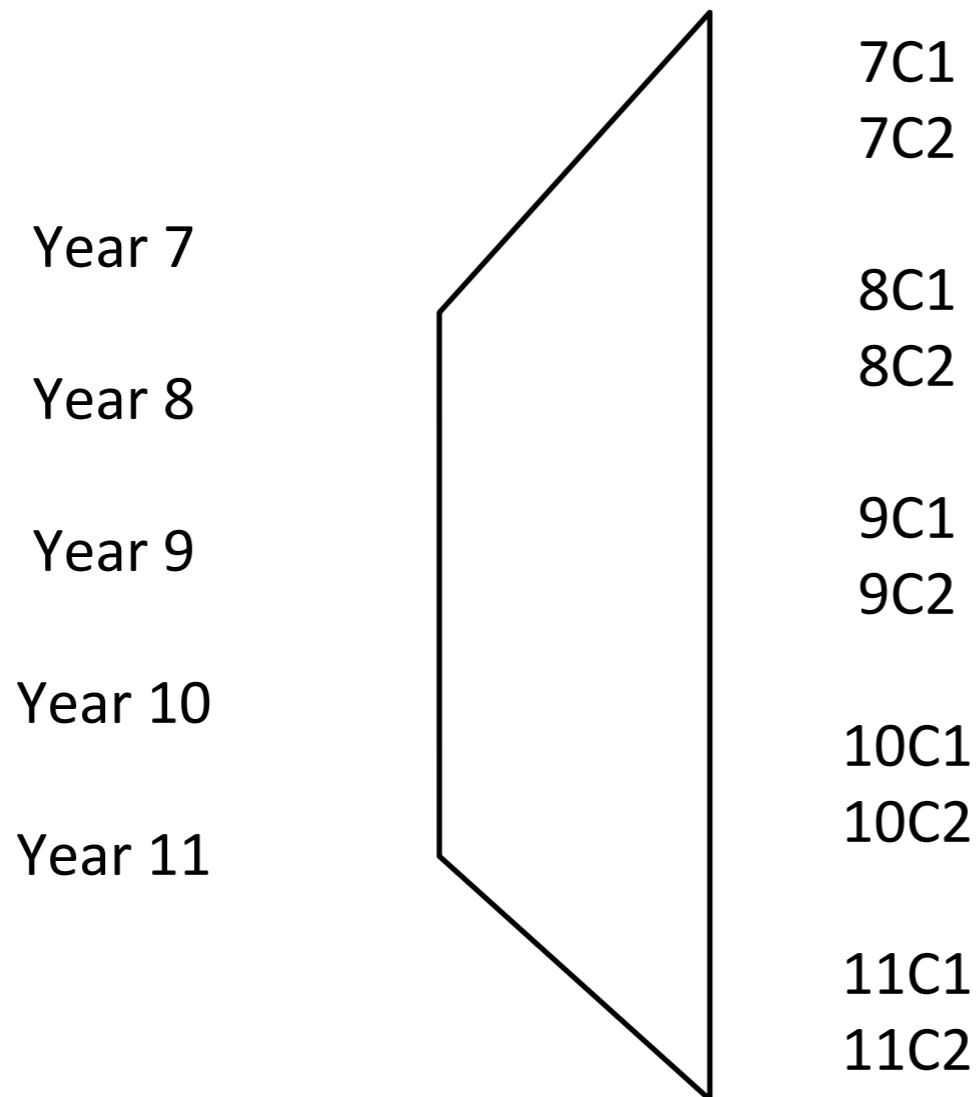

Tutor Group and Houses

Tutor Groups

- Usually a tutor will remain in charge of a tutor group from year 7-11.
- Building positive relationship with tutees and parents / carers.
- Overview of academic and personal progress.
- Tutor registers students in the morning and afternoon.
- Maintains high standards, i.e. uniform, equipment.
- Personal tutoring – time to discuss concerns, successes, future plans etc.



Induction Day



- **Wednesday the 4th of September 2019** all new students begin at Norton Hill by attending an Induction Day.
- Only the new Year 7's and Year 12's will be in school.
- **8:40am - Students should arrive at Norton Hill School in their Norton Hill School Uniform. Go to main hall.**
- Divide them again into their Houses and tutor groups.
- They will spend the day with their tutor group and House team and be fully briefed on all the opportunities and expectations of Norton Hill School.
- Spend a portion of the day touring the school to help them find their way around as quickly as possible.
- **3:25pm - School day ends. Students can be collected from school or make their own way home.**
- Optional Induction day parent/carer evening.
- **3:30pm – 5:00pm – House staff and Mrs Gibbs will be available to discuss any concerns you may have.** Please either contact the school reception before 3:30pm on this day to make an appointment, or alternatively drop into the school between the above times.

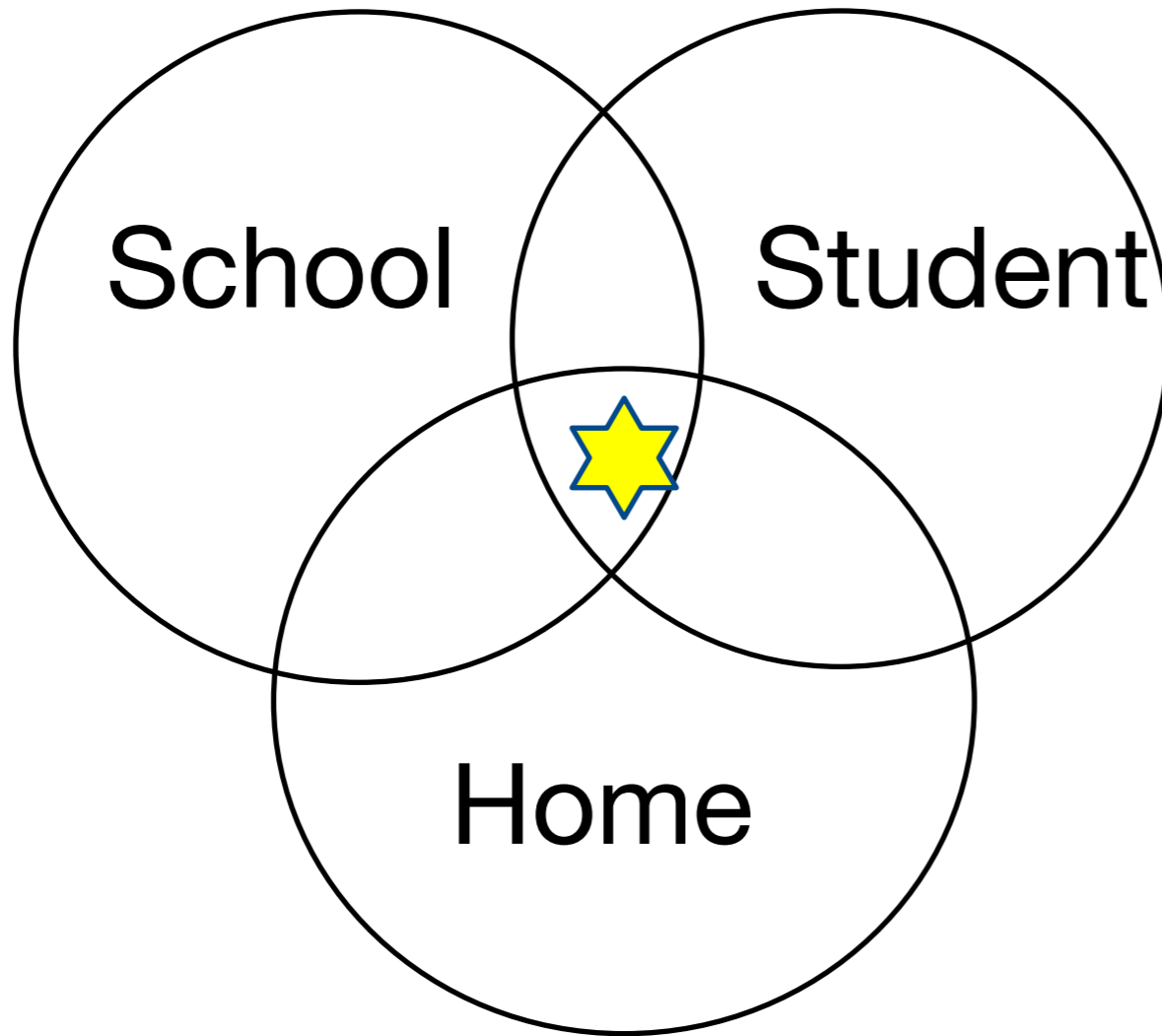
