# <u>Year 1 Topic Web – Term 1</u>

#### <u>English</u>

Our core text this term will be 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers. We will be writing an adventure story based on this book.

### <u>SPaG</u>

Capital letters and full stops Use capital letters for names of people and the pronoun 'l'.

#### Science

We will be learning about Everyday Materials. We will identify a variety of common materials, distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made, describe materials according to their properties and describe why some materials suit certain objects better than others.

#### <u>Humanities</u>

We will be learning about changes within living memory in History. We will be learning years, decades, century and generations. We will also be learning the changes that have happened within our own lifetimes, and that artefacts help to ask and answer questions about how life has changed over time. We will develop an understanding of chronology within living memory and in within the context of our pupils' own family.

In this unit, pupils will be designing a windmill. They will understand that the shape of materials can be changed to improve the strength and stiffness of structures, that cylinders are a strong type of structure, that axles are used in structures and mechanisms to make parts turn in a circle. Pupils will also begin to understand that different structures are used for different purposes and know that a structure is something that has been made and put together.

#### <u>RE</u>

We will be learning ab<mark>out God and Creation and answering the question, "What do Christians believe about God?"</mark>

#### PE

In this unit, the children will develop their understanding of the benefits of exercise and a healthy lifestyle on their physical body, their mood and their overall health. They will work independently, in pairs and small groups to complete challenges in which they will sometimes need to persevere to achieve their personal best.

#### <u>PSHE</u>

Our PSHE scheme is called 'Jigsaw' and there are six puzzles (units) over the year. Our first puzzle is called 'Being Me in My World', where we will learn: to feel special and safe, about our class, our rights and responsibilies, rewards and feeling proud, consequences and owning our learning charter.

#### <u>Art</u>

This term, we will be exploring mark making and line by working and experimenting with different materials through observational and collaborative pieces.

#### <u>Music</u>

Our focus will be Pulse and Rhythm and our theme is 'All About Me'. We will be doing lots of activities for getting to know one another. Through listening to a range of different music and playing games, the children will learn to identify the difference between the pulse and rhythm of a song and consolidate

their understanding of these concepts through listening and performing activities.

#### Computer Science

Our focus this term is 'Technology all around us'. Our pupils will develop their understanding of technology and how it can help them in their everyday lives. They will start to become familiar with the different components of a computer by developing their keyboard and mouse skills. The children will also consider how to use technology responsibly.

#### <u>Maths</u>

Our Maths Scheme is called 'Power Maths'. We will be focusing on numbers to 10, representing a part– whole model within 10 and adding and subtracting within 10.
