

## E-Safety Responsible Use Agreement

All pupils use computer facilities including internet access as an essential part of learning, as required by the National Curriculum. Both pupils and their parents/carers are asked to.

## E-Safety Rules

- We ask permission before using the internet.
- We do not stream music, download or purchase anything over the internet.
- We do not access social networking sites or internet chat rooms because we understand that these have age limits.
- We only use educational games with the consent of an adult.
- We only use websites that an adult has chosen.
- We tell an adult if we see anything that we are uncomfortable with.
- We immediately close any webpage we are not sure about.
- We only open emails from known people and we don't open attachments.
- We only email people an adult has approved and we send emails that are polite and friendly.
- We never give out personal information or passwords.
- We never arrange to meet anyone we don't know and we understand about 'stranger danger'.
- We do not bring mobile phones or any other electronic devices into school.
- We understand information on the internet my not be accurate.
- We understand that teachers will monitor my use of ICT.
