This week at Nursery ...

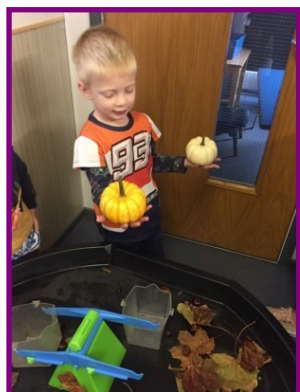
