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This week at Nursery ...

At Next Steps we have had a very exciting week!



We have had new sensory experiences, using our hands to explore the texture of tapioca 'frogspawn.' We have been investigating the life cycle of a frog, learning new vocabulary explaining the stages a frog goes through.











We have enjoyed reading the story "Who is in the egg?" Finding out about which animals come from eggs, and the children have made some lovely pictures of the animals in the book, hatching from an egg.

In forest school, the children have enjoyed Easter egg hunts, searching high and low for the hidden eggs.



We have also had Easter egg hunts in maths, where the children have found numbered eggs, and putting them into sequence or finding the same number of items to match the numeral on the egg. The children have enjoyed hiding the eggs themselves, for their friends to find.

Also in maths, the children have been counting chicks into a nest, matching numeral to quantity, some children even enjoying the challenge of adding two groups together. We think they may be preparing to keep an eye on their Easter eggs, in case any go missing!!

We have learned about the true meaning behind Easter and the children have showed a good understanding and recall of the stories we have shared.
