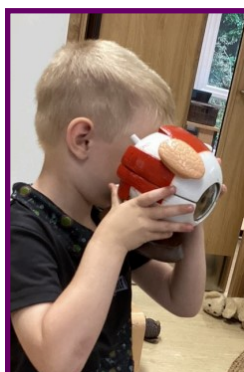


This week has been another busy week!
