# Message from the Headteacher

Three weeks in to term 1 and Autumn is well and truly in our sights now! There is a very positive mood and feel around the school and, when visiting classrooms, I have been so impressed by the purposeful, calm atmosphere. Yesterday I showed a family, hoping to join the St John's community, around our school and they were so impressed by your children. They commented on how polite the children were as numerous doors were held open for us. They noticed how well the children spoke to each other showing respect and care, but also how productive all the children were in their classrooms. Well done everyone. You made me feel proud!

We made it through a rather wet (and windy) day on Wednesday and our first 'wet playtime' of the year! Please can I ask that all children bring a coat into school everyday as we go out to play in all (except extreme!) weather. As the weather gets wetter, we ask that if your children would like to choose to play on the field at lunchtimes, they bring in a spare pair of named shoes or wellies to change in to.

I have also had the pleasure of looking through a selection of the children's Writing and Maths books this week. I was struck by the quality of the writing and the use of ambitious vocabulary from children across the year groups. Many of the classes are coming to the end of their learning sequence and I am really looking forward to seeing all their amazing ideas come to life in their independent writing!

There are things we need to work on too and writing forms a big part of our School Improvement plan (SIP) this year. I will share more on this throughout the coming terms as we see developments being made.

I was impressed with the work in Maths books. The teachers are working hard to teach the children to know more and remember more and this is clearly evident in the children's books. Just encouraging your children to complete 10-15 minutes a day at home with DoodleMaths will really support them with practicing the fundamental maths skills which are key to lifelong learning.
