Last term Owl's had such fun learning our 'All About Me' topic! I also enjoyed meeting with you all on parents evening and sharing the great progress and successful learning taking place in Owl Class.

Just a couple of reminders:

If there is NO comment in the reading diary we will assume your child has not read and will not change books.
- We encourage the children to drink water daily, so please make sure that they have their NAMED water bottle with them every day and that your child has some named fruit or vegetable to eat mid-morning.
- PE will continue to be on a Tuesday and Forest Friday sessions each Friday morning.

I have arranged a reading information meeting to help support you hearing your child read at home and information on the 'Unlocking Letters and Sounds' phonics teaching scheme we use in school on Tuesday 7th November at 2.30pm in the school hall.
