Please help us by ensuring that ALL items of clothing are clearly marked with your child's name. We require all children to have a full PE Kit in school at all times, clearly labelled and in an appropriate bag.

For safety reasons, children must not wear shoes with a high heel to school or trousers with an excessive flare. Equally, only 1 pair of stud earrings are allowed and children should wear no other jewellery. All earrings must be removed before PE. We are keen to encourage independence and responsibility. Your child is responsible for his/her belongings and the school cannot be held responsible for any losses.

We discourage children from bringing personal/valuable belongings into school; this avoids things being lost or broken.

Hairstyles: Long hair should be tied back at all times, particularly during PE. Children should not be sent to school with extreme haircuts or hairstyles. Haircuts and hairstyles must be of conservative style, no mohican, mullet, or layered colours and extensions would be suitable. There should be no lines or patterns cut into the hair. Hair bands must be school colours, and no fashion accessories including large bows and fashion headbands as these are uncomfortable for the children to wear over a period of time but also can be very distracting.

Children must not bring to school any items of great value, as we are not covered for loss or damage to property. Shoes should be smart black school shoes and appropriate for school. Black trainers should not be worn as shoes.

We do not allow nail polish or tattoos to be worn in school.
