This term we are learning about Spring and our Christian Value for the term is Hope. We have started the topic with a focus on the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar'. We have held lots of exciting activities to support the children's learning. This Included butterfly symmetrical paintings, where the children were exploring patterns by blotting paint onto kitchen paper and making 'butterfly wings'. We used different pasta shapes to understand the life cycle of the butterfly.











On Monday, the children enjoyed Forest School. It was a dry, clear day but luckily there were still lots of puddles and mud to explore! We have spent time in the playground using pom-poms, dancing to music and we really enjoyed doing the conga all through the nursery and the outside area with Bessie!
