This week has been another exciting and busy week at Next Steps!

We began the week learning all about the life cycle of a flower and in particular daffodils, as the children were pleased to see our daffodils growing in the planters in the playground.



We have enjoyed sharing the story 'That's Not a Daffodil', - a lovely tale about a boy observing the changing plant as it grows. He describes it in some funny ways, for example "Grampa's hairs in the wind!"

The children enjoyed investigating real daffodils in different stages of growth and learned new vocabulary such as roots and bulbs. They used this knowledge to complete a cutting and sticking sequencing activity.



We have also been creative, making our own flower pictures but we are keeping them as a surprise for a special day next week. Watch this space!



At Forest School this week we enjoyed exploring the mud!! It reminded us of pictures from past years at Glastonbury Festival! The children have really grown in confidence in the woodland, joining in with activities and following instructions to return to the 'log circle' when staff call "1, 2, 3, where are you?"



Please note that the new funding for 2 year olds for eligible 'working' families will be available from 1st April 2024. A funding code is required from HMRC which can be obtained by 31st March 2024 to start receiving funding from 1st April 2024. The funding will start the term after the 2nd Birthday, Applications should be made at https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/

Two-year funding is still available for families who are entitled to additional government funding. A code is required from the Local Authority and parents can apply at https://pages/home
