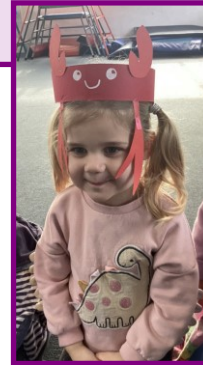




Next week is incredibly busy! We have several things happening for you to be aware of:
