The tomato frog and the red-eyed tree frog have different defence mechanisms. How are they different?

Accept any answer which makes a comparison between the tomato frog making themselves appear larger and the red-eyed tree frog blending in with its environment or flashing its red eyes.

- · The two frogs' defence mechanisms are different because the tomato frog puffs itself up to appear bigger but the red-eyed tree frog blends in so it can't be seen.
- · The tomato frog makes itself look bigger but the red-eyed tree frog uses its red eyes to confuse predators meaning that it can escape.
