Language For Life Programme

Next Steps are part of the Language for Life programme. This is a focussed assessment tool that helps us to support children's language and communication development and identify specific areas to focus on when planning activities.

We also receive support and advice from an allocated speech and language therapist for our setting. If you would like more information about this feel free to ask a member of staff.

Families are invited to speak with members of the Language for Life team, including the speech and language therapists and a member of the early years team. Families can ask any questions about their child's language and communication development.

If we do not receive anything, we will assume that you intend your child to attend the nursery until the end of August and we will invoice accordingly.
