This week, we have been reflecting upon Remembrance Day and talking to the children about why people choose to wear poppies.

We have spent time making beautiful art work, and the children have also watched a short Cbeebies animation which depicts war from the perspective of animals.

The children have thought about what it means to be brave when we are afraid of things, just like all people affected by war and conflict.

Across the nursery, there have been other exciting things happening. During this week's Forest School, the children made forest fireworks. They collected sticks, leaves and other natural decorations, and with the help of the adults, they attached them to make colourful and vibrant firework sticks! The children then talked to each other about the noises that fireworks make and their experiences of watching them over the weekend.

We have also spent some time in the studio completing an obstacle course, practicing our gross motor skills and concentrating hard to keep our balance.

Pre-school children joined in with their first phonics sessions this week. This is a play based group activity which introduces children to phonic sounds and is based upon tuning into initial sounds in words. These sounds will progressively build and the children will be introduced to more sounds as their pre-school year continues

In maths we have been learning to link numeral to quantity, feeding amounts of acorns to match the numeral shown on the squirrel.
