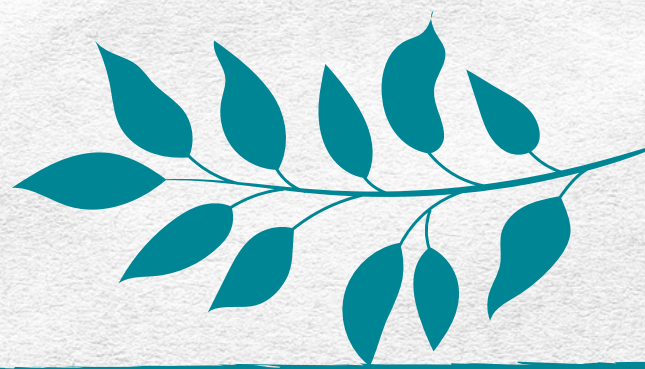




WHAT A WONDERFUL WORLD
